INFORMATION WE COLLECT

You can visit Paley Rothman's website without providing any personally identifiable information ("PII") other than the information we collect automatically. You may choose to give us PII in a variety of situations. For example, if you subscribe to receive information, or register for webinars, conferences and events you will be asked to provide certain PII that may include your name, address, email address, company, position, physical address, telephone number, fax number, and preferences. We may also ask for your PII when you express an interest in employment opportunities at Paley Rothman by submitting an application through our website. The information we collect from you will be made apparent at the time you are submitting your application, and we will use this information only to evaluate your employment candidacy.

We collect standard information about Paley Rothman users such as browser type, operating system, what you searched for, referring and exit pages, the dates and times of visits, and other website usage behavior called "Site Visitation Data" (SVD). SVD is used to administer the website and provide general statistics regarding the use of Paley Rothman's website.

Biographical Information: We may automatically request and collect information about you when you visit the website, such as your gender, your age, and your online interests.

Navigational Information: We automatically collect information related to how you got to the website, such as the website from which you came, and the website to which you navigate after leaving our website, what pages you visit on the website, how long you stay on pages, how many pages you visit, and if you complete any forms on the website. Some of this information is anonymous, as it does not permit us to identify you personally. However, we may associate this information with your PII if you provide it, or have provided PII to us.

Cookies, Flash Cookies, Clear gif files & Web Beacons: The website may also use cookies, flash cookies, clear gif file, web beacons and other technologies to recognize users, customize their experience, or target marketing.

A cookie is a small text file that a website's server places on a user's computer, mobile phone, or other device. The cookie transmits information back to the website's server about the browsing activities of the user. This includes information such as pages and content viewed, the time and duration of visits, and what links a user may have clicked on the website. Cookies can also be used to recognize users and maintain data related to a particular individual, including passwords. In some contexts, such as where a number of separate websites participate in a network, cookies can be used to track a user across different sites. Cookies are used as a standard practice by many sites. Certain features of our website may use local stored objects (or Flash cookies) to collect and store information about your preferences and navigation to, from, and on our website. Flash cookies are not managed by the same browser settings as are used for browser cookies. Pages of our the website and our e-mails may contain small electronic files

known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single-pixel gifs) that permit Paley Rothman, for example, to count users who have visited those pages or (opened an email) and for other related website statistics (for example, recording the popularity of certain website content and verifying system and server integrity).

The use of cookies by our third-party partners and vendors, affiliates, tracking utility company, service providers is not covered by our privacy policy. Our partners, affiliates, tracking utility company, service providers use session ID cookies to make it easier for you to navigate our website. We do not have access or control over these third-party cookies.

If you would prefer not to accept cookies from our website or any third-party service provider or other website, you can modify the settings in your browser. You may refer to your browser's online help feature or user manual for instructions on how to do this. If you refuse to accept cookies, it is possible that some portions of the website may not function as intended.

USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION (PII)

We will treat your PII as confidential, and we will not share your PII with third parties without your permission, except in the limited circumstances described below.

We may provide your PII to third parties for the purposes of operating our business, delivering, improving, and customizing our client services, sending marketing and other communications related to our business, and for other legitimate purposes permitted by applicable law or otherwise with your consent, as may be required by applicable law or in response to a lawful subpoena.
